We know there have been some questions about how that process works. Please consider this a notice, explanation, and invitation to join us.

Look for meeting notices on the LSTCA website, in some MatSu Borough announcements, in lodges, and other areas around the lake.

Following Roberts Rules of Order, we make every attempt to begin meetings on time. Community members desiring to speak at any meeting must contact the board's President prior to the board meeting. This can be done by email, in person, or in written form.

Individuals desiring to speak who have not made prior contact may sign up as a speaker on the day of the meeting prior to the beginning of the meeting. Signing up the day of the meeting is subject to availability of time on the agenda.

Each individual will be allotted no more than 3 minutes for comment. Public participation at board meetings will be limited to 30 minutes. These time allotments may be extended in 15 minute increments, by the board President/Chair, at his/her discretion. Total public participation at board meetings will be limited to between 30 and 90 minutes.

If there is an issue or concern to the Community that requires more than this allotted time; a separate meeting, to address the issue will be scheduled in as timely a manner as possible.
